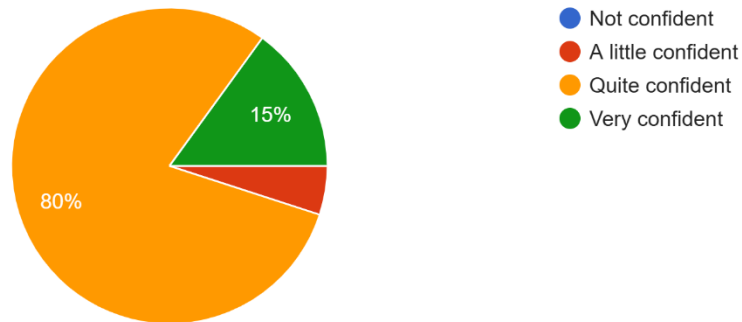

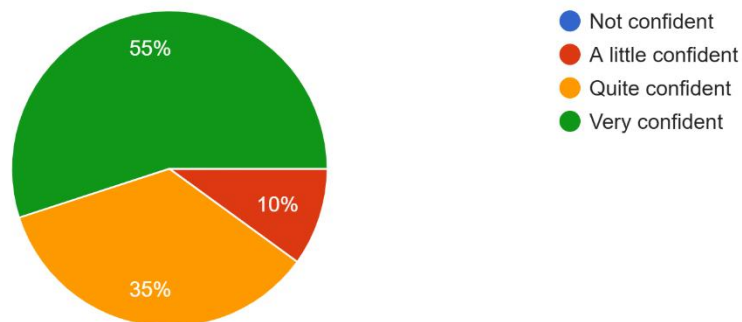
Before the project, how confident did you feel using digital tools (computers, apps, online platforms)?

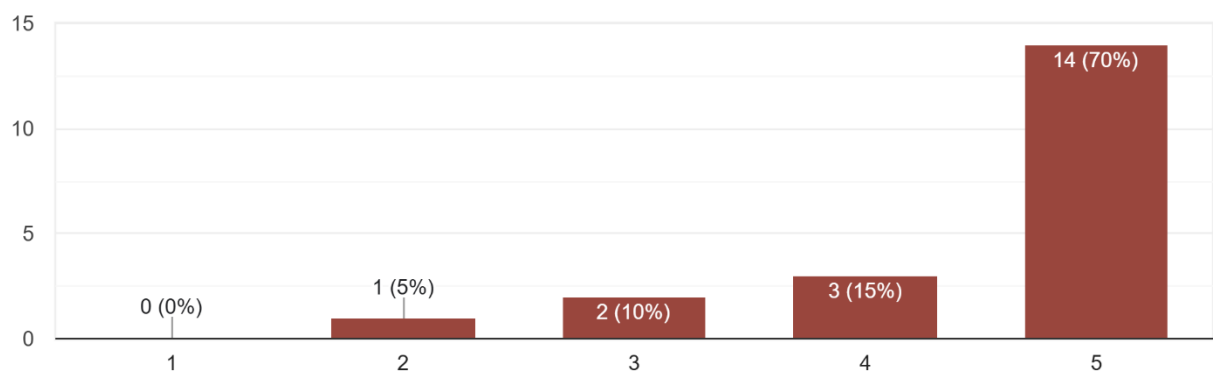

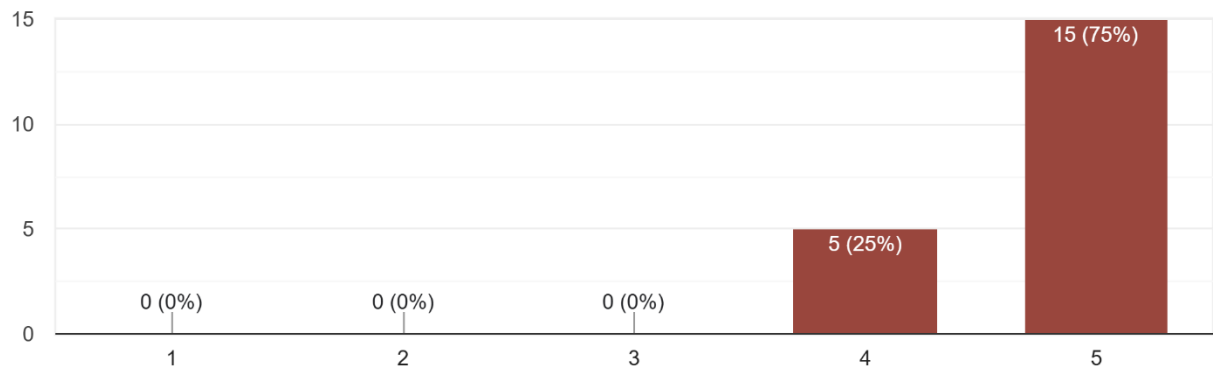

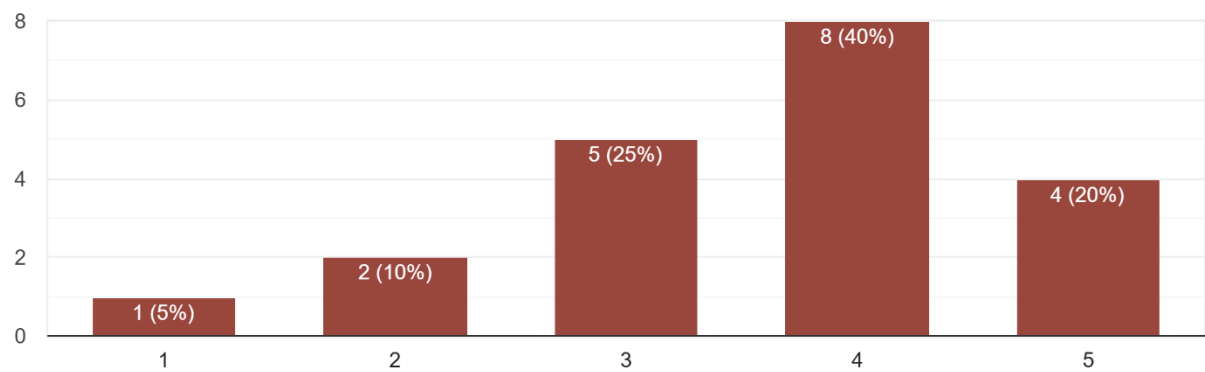

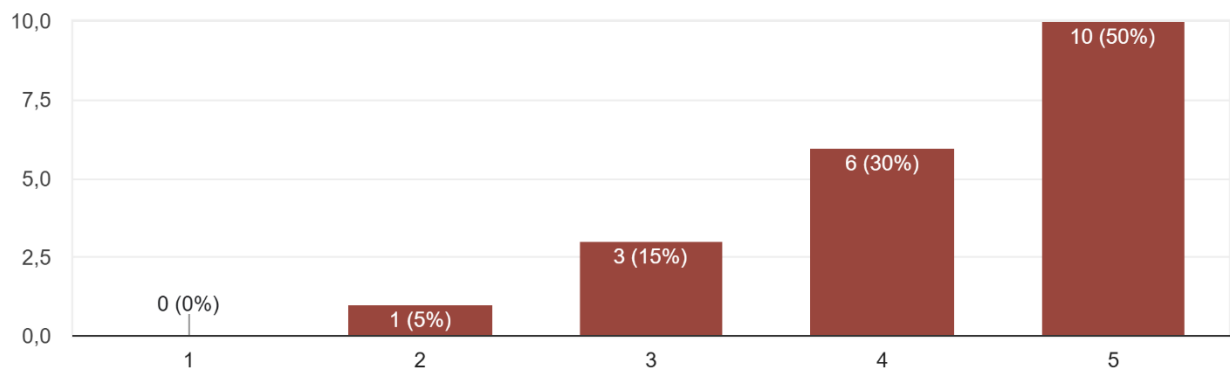

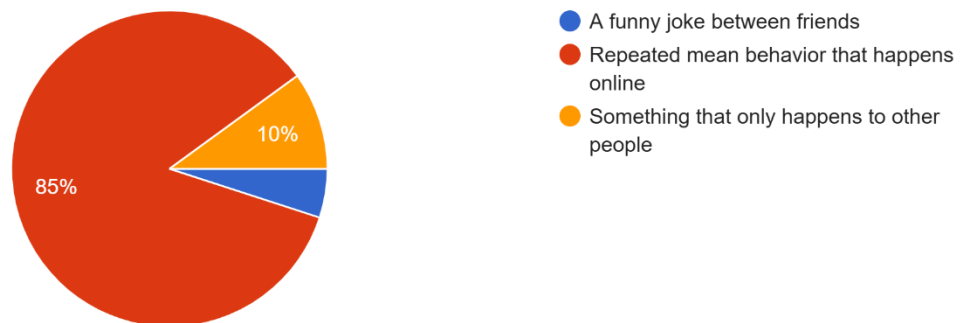

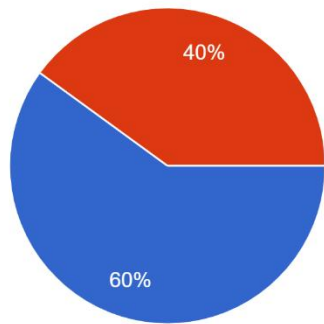
